Footnotes

QUEEN'O'DABALL was unhurried along the rail around the first turn, advanced between foes down the backstretch, rallied three wide around the far turn, swept to command in upper stretch and drew off under a drive. LANDON DID IT set the pace along the rail, could not keep pace with the winner in upper stretch and was clearly second best. GOLDEN STYLE stalked the pace two wide, was no match for the top two but held well clear for the show. I DID IT THAT TIME failed to menace while racing three wide. JUST A TRICK bumped with DIXIELAND SILK just after the start, had early speed along the rail, angled two wide midway around the first turn, pressed the pace down the backstretch and faltered around the far turn. FLIRTING SONG was outrun while racing two and three wide. DIXIELAND SILK bumped with JUST A TRICK just after the start and was outrun inside.
