DIVI DIVI rallied four wide turn, gained the lead in the upper stretch, drew off through the stretch under a drive. YOU KNOW I WANCHA stalked the leaders from the rail, bid three wide on the turn but could not gain on the winner while clearly second best. BANCO BANNER forced the pace four wide, angled down into the turn then was no match for the top two in the drive. HOLY STONE prompted the issue three wide, steadied into the turn when BANCO BANNER angled down then lacked a late response. TIZ BOLD set the pace on rail, remained a factor around the turn, gave way in the drive. FUR LINED lunged at the start, was within striking distance four wide, lacked a late bid. PERPETUITY pressed the pace just off the rail, stopped after a half. The rider of HOLY STONE claimed foul against BANCO BANNER alleging interference into the last turn. The Stewards reviewed the video tape replays and disqualified BANCO BANNER from third and placed her fourth.
