ROSES FOR ALYSE four wide backstretch, gained the lead approaching the sixteenth pole and under a hard drive prevailed. SENORITA ROSE saved ground, angled out for the drive then closed with a rush. WILD GOOSE CHASE stalked the pace four and five wide, finished strong. BIRDIES FILET bid six wide around the turn, finished fastest of all. ME FOXY set the pace on a clear lead, weakened in the stretch. VIRGINIA STAR moved up three wide on the turn, lacked a late response. THISWOODSFORYOU passed tiring rivals. PRINCESS DOTTIE well placed, had no rally. TIME TO WIN hard used, tired. GLORY HILL was outrun.
