DEAR GRACE stalked the early pace from the outside, advanced entering the second turn, made a bid entering the drive and was clear late while under steady urging. BELLE OF CAMDEN unhurried early, advanced outside up the backstretch, reached a forward position entering the drive but could not reach the winner. NEW ENGLANDER forced the early pace from the outside, remained forward entering the drive but could not keep pace. DEWAMERE chased the early pace from the outside but had nothing left. MISTRESS D'CAT could only pass tired ones. SILVER BUCKLE went evenly. SCOOT THEM BOOTS was no factor. SCRUB ISLAND was no threat. NANA LOUISE set the early pace and gave way.
