LOVE'S STRONG HART prompted the pace from the rail, gained the lead near the sixteenth pole and drew off. LOVE TO THE MAX forced the issue three wide, finished willingly. AWHOLENEBALLGAME set the pace under heavy pressure, dug in around the turn but was out finished. SIR EDGAR with the leaders just off the rail, lacked a closing bid. WONDER LITE rallied along the rail around the turn, failed to sustain his bid. NATURAL SEVEN within striking distance four and five wide, failed to respond. FAST GEAR never threatened three wide. VENTURE CAPITAL three and four wide, lacked the needed rally.
