CHESS MASTER dueled from the inside for the early lead, shook loose entering the turn, opened a clear margin at the eighth pole and was clear late while kept to task. WHITEHOUSE RIDGE dueled from the outside for the early lead, remained a forward factor entering the drive but could not match strides. SPIKE THE DIESEL chased the early pace from the outside, remained forward but was no match for the top two while holding position. UNIQUE INCIDENT went evenly. DANCENSING chased the early pace from the outside but was no threat late. HI IT'S ME was no factor. INDY O. was no threat. A NEW YODELER had a steady fade.
