NICOLES PROSPECT dueled from the outside for the early lead, gained a clear margin up the backstretch, widen the effort entering the second turn, remained clear at the eighth pole then was all out to last. BAIANO stalked the early pace from the outside, inched closer entering the second turn, responded when sat down for the drive but could not reach the winner. HE'S RISING well placed from the inside, advanced up the backstretch, made a bid along the rail entering the drive and was gaining late. MR. MARKET forced the early pace outside but had nothing left. SHOW THE WAY went evenly. LAST TRIBUTE was no factor. JOHNNY THROTTLE was always outrun.
