Footnotes

GENERAL RUTLEDGE , three wide the first turn, angled in after sprinting clear approaching the first turn, set the pace and held sway under urging. MOLINARO PADRINO stumbled leaving the starting gate, saved ground, drifted out near the sixteenth pole and finished willingly. TOUGH TALKING , three wide the second and third turns, rallied slightly. NINJA NEKIA , a forward factor two wide the far turn, weakened. REAL QUIET TIME saved ground and was not a factor. HABOUR SHARK had brief speed along the rail then faded. TOUCHER was outrun. GOOD AND BAD showed speed in the two path and faltered on the backstretch.
