SNUNNER moved up four wide, gained a slim lead in the upper stretch, held clear under a drive. MOULIN D'OR saved ground, rallied four wide around the turn, loomed but hung in the drive. HOPEWEBREAKEVEN forced the pace inside, finished well. SOUTHSRING GINGER prompted the issue three wide, lacked a late response. CARA'S CARRERA saved ground, rallied too late four wide. MARQUETRY'S CROWN set the pace under heavy pressure, gave way around the turn. SULTRY SISTER pressed the issue, stopped after a half.
