Footnotes

BURNT OFFERING, four wide the opening turn, stalked the pace two deep after the first quarter mile, took the lead at the nine sixteenths pole, drew clear a furlong later, was pressured near the quarter pole, widened on the final turn and held on while flattening stride late. C V'S DEVELEN settled well back off the rail, started a bid at the five sixteenths pole, eased outward rounding the final turn, entered the stretch six wide and was closing steadily before running out of ground. SHOP SMART settled close to the pace off the rail, was hemmed in leaving the three eighths pole, started a run from the five sixteenths pole, raced hemmed in through the final turn, bid four wide in the upper stretch and finished evenly. FLYING SPEED, well back toward the outside, bid leaving the three eighths pole, rounded the final turn five wide and passed tiring rivals. NOAH'S HARVEST rated with the early pace inside, dropped back through the second turn, gave close chase down the backstretch, was blocked on the final turn, came between horses midstretch but had little left from there. BIGUM had a slim lead three wide the opening turn, rated the pace to the nine sixteenths pole, gave chase from the half pole then leveled off near the rail rounding the final turn. WYATT'S HOPE, off the pace toward the outside, was not a factor. GOLD RAPTOR rated close to the early pace about the three path, bid nearing the three eighths pole, took aim approaching the final turn but gave way in the lane. I'M NOT A BABY, off the pace about the four path, bid from the three eighths pole then faded on the final turn. FIRSTIE was not a factor while saving ground.
