Footnotes

PEPPER BAY stalked the pace off the rail, challenged from the three eighths pole, took over nearing the quarter, surged clear midway on the final turn and opened up under steady handling. FOXY DRUMMER rated close to the early pace inside, bid leaving the three eighths pole, eased outward from the three sixteenths pole, left the final turn in the six path and dueled for place a sixteenth away while not a match for the winner. UNCLE BETTY rated a short lead inside, was pressured leaving the three eighths pole, caught toward the quarter, dropped back mid turn then leveled off down the lane. WATERLOO JUNCTION settled just off the pace inside, picked up the chase from the seven sixteenths pole but had little left in the stretch. LANDER ROAD, off the pace in the four and five paths, improved off the rail rounding the final turn, raced evenly down the lane then vanned off post race. SALUTE ME BACK stalked the pace about the five path, gave chase toward the seven sixteenths pole, lost some ground on the final turn, was carried out entering the stretch and weakened. SHE'S OUT OF MONEY raced well back about the three path. GOBLINS DANCER saved ground off the pace. RICH RED VINO raced wide early and was not a factor. BLUE GRASS BOOM raced toward mid track and was through after a half mile.
