Footnotes

CATALONIA vied three wide down the backstretch, came in nearing the five-sixteenths pole, causing PROMISE ME to check sharply, edged clear in the two path around the far turn and just lasted. COCO COBANA settled off the pace, raced three wide around the turn, angled further out in upper stretch, continued on her left lead, rallied through the lane and just missed. SWEET CONTENT advanced three wide around the turn, dropped back a bit turning for home, re-rallied between foes but was out kicked. SEAHAG vied along the rail early and was outfinished in the lane. AIX EN PROVENCE raced along the rail and lacked the needed rally. PROMISE ME vied between foes early, checked sharply when the winner angled in nearing the five-sixteenths pole, raced two wide around the turn and lacked room for much of the stretch run. WE BE GOOD hesitated at the start and trailed off the rail.
