Footnotes

STREET NOISE, jostled at the start, lacked room inside early on, eased out leaving the first turn, improved steadily outside down the backstretch, started his bid at the five sixteenths pole, dueled to the front midway on the final turn, dug in to draw clear midstretch and held on well. SHINY BLUE settled back off the rail, bid from the seven sixteenths pole, rounded the final turn four wide and dug in through the lane to get up for place the closing strides. SHOOTMETOTHEMOON, well back off the rail, bid leaving the five sixteenths pole, eased five wide rounding the final turn and steadily improved to share show. SIR FIT'S TOO MUCH stumbled leaving the gate, closed toward contention four wide, stalked the pace entering the backstretch, was urged to the front past the three eighths pole, drew clear approaching the quarter, was caught midway on the final turn but continued a close factor through the upper

stretch before weakening. FUZZYWUZZYWUZABEAR settled close to the early pace inside, was shuffled back approaching the quarter pole, lacked room rounding the final turn, steadied toward the head of the lane and lacked a clear path through the lane. NICK'S BLITZ, off the pace and off the rail, made a four wide bid leaving the seven sixteenths pole, took aim nearing the final turn but leveled off saving ground. JAEGERMANN raced well back saving ground. STAMEN was hustled to a slim lead while saving ground early, rated his speed to the seven sixteenths pole, was pressured when caught past the three eighths and faded readily from there. SPRING AT EM, off the pace toward mid track, gave chase leaving the three eighths pole, leveled off rounding the final turn and gave way down the lane. GETAWAY MONEY, off the early pace about the three path, dropped back rounding the first turn.
