SAVAGE STYLE stalked the pace, rallied into the final turn then dueled gamely through the stretch, gradually moving clear. GARNER KEY rated off the pace, made a bid into the final turn, took a short lead nearing the three sixteenths pole, lost some ground entering the stretch, dueled gamely but let go nearing the wire. SPRING TIME CARI was unhurried early, rallied outside into the final turn and bested the others. GUNNYS GIRL, off the pace, lost some ground into the stretch then passed tired ones. MINER'S GLOW, unhurried early on, made a bid into the final turn but lacked room on the rail through the stretch. ROCKY TURN set a pressured pace, contested the lead inside through the backstretch, was steadied nearing the final turn then faded. O'S PERFECTION was hustled up, contested the lead down the backstretch, had the lead into the final turn then weakened from the three sixteenths pole. AN ALERT POLE was no factor. MOON ELLIPSE pressured the pace from the inside down the backstretch then faded nearing the far turn. O'LARCAIN gave way after half mile.
