Footnotes

KALAS dropped back from an inside position to stalk the pace two deep leaving the half mile pole, took control nearing the three eighths, was soon clear, pressured from the quarter pole and held well under steady stretch encouragement. MAHARANI URSULA, off the pace outside, bid leaving the seven sixteenths pole, saved ground on the final turn, finished well though had to settle for second best. PUNK ROBINSON settled back inside, eased out to give chase nearing the five sixteenths pole, entered the stretch about the four path and leveled off after achieving third. RIGHT ON TIME rated just off the pace inside, made a mild bid through the backstretch and had nothing left in the lane. ENOCHI, edgy in the gate, rated a short lead off the rail leaving the five eighths pole, was caught nearing the three eighths, gave chase from there then faded on the final turn. CROWN THE PRINCE kept close to the early pace about the three path, gave chase leaving the first turn but faded after a half mile.
