CRAZY BEAR stalked the pace two wide, came three wide into the lane, steadily gained in the middle of the track and was up in deep stretch. MY REWARD was unhurried inside, advanced three wide around the far turn, came five wide into the lane, rallied on the far outside and finished fastest of all. CATCHPENNY LASS pressed the pace two wide, took the lead nearing the sixteenth pole and weakened late. TORI'S BREEZE steadied early, saved ground toward the rear of the field and had a mild inside rally. KASHAYA set a pressured pace along the rail and tired in the lane. LE SONJA failed to menace while racing four wide. JUSTICE DENIED was not a factor while racing three wide. BOBBIESQUEEN stalked the pace three wide and tired after a half.
