Footnotes

SINATRA'SRAZEDBROW rated with the pace two deep, moved to the front at the half mile pole, was passed a furlong later, gave chase from that point to regain control toward the head of the lane, edged clear midstretch and held on well. KING OF SCOTTLAND rated a short lead inside, dropped back at the half mile pole, recovered the front end at the three eighths, contested the advantage through the final turn but was caught nearing the head of the lane, reluctantly ceded from a close duel and leveled off approaching the wire. MEDIATE, boxed at the rail the opening turn, moved to the outside at the half mile pole, gave chase five wide down the backstretch, saved ground on the final turn then dueled for show. NEVER MOBIL angled out from the heels of rivals into the first turn, rated close three wide, gave chase leaving the three eighths pole, saved some ground on the final turn and had no further response. RAGING WILD FIRE was carried out entering the first turn, rated close to the early pace four wide, gave chase leaving the three eighths pole then faded on the final turn.
