AMERI HOLLY pressured the pace from between horses, dropped back from the winner into the stretch and won the duel for place. WORTH THE KISSIN pressed the pace from the outside, dropped back entering the stretch and finished evenly. CLASSY T chased the pace and ran evenly through the stretch. FANCY FEET STACEY showed no speed then offered a mild stretch bid off the rail. LINCOLN ABBEY showed no speed then had no rally while saving ground. BODEGAS, off the pace, had no rally. STORY OF LOVE chased the pace racing widest then tired. GOLDIE'S CLAIM chased the pace down the backstretch then gave way. BRAAK'S INDIAN was outrun.
