Footnotes

BEAUALLIS hard pressed setting the pace, moved clear on the turn but was all out to last. T. V. SECRETARY saved ground, rallied three wide around the turn and closed with a rush. TUFTON AVENUE three wide along the backstretch, dropped to the rail in the upper stretch and finished strongly. LADY LARRUPIN pressed the pace just off the rail, lacked a late response. PARSIPPANY shuffled back down the backstretch from the inside, lacked a closing bid. DEBBIE'S GONE stalked the pace three and four wide, failed to respond. SHE'S A DEPUTY five wide for the first half, never threatened. GRAVEL GERTIE rushed up three wide along the backstretch, flattened out.
