MIRACLE MIST broke sharp from the inside to gain a clear early margin, widen the advantage entering the turn, remained well clear at the eighth pole and was never threatened while in hand throughout and never asked. IT'S A FRANCES DAY stalked the early pace from the outside, made a bid entering the drive and closed well. PARTNER V P forced the early pace from the outside, remained forward but could not keep pace. SHEBE WONDERFUL chased the early pace inside but had nothing left. MAKIN A BANNER could only pass tired ones. STARRY VALLEY was no factor. EXPRESSO CREAM was no threat. LIL CHAMP chased the early pace inside and tired. LITTLE CARD was always outrun.
