CATALPA pressed the pace, drew off around the turn, held clear through the stretch under a drive. WILD BLUE YONDER moved up four and five wide to be second best. LOOKING FOR AIR prompted the issue from the inside, lacked a late response. GEORGIA RAIN set the early pace, was lugging out around the turn, checked and fell back. WORK FOR PEACE within striking distance along the inside, lacked a closing bid. MISS OIL four wide, lacked the needed late rally. MIEL DE ROSE flashed early speed along the rail, steadily faded. INDIAN OPAL six wide down the backstretch, was no factor. MAE BE WINKING showed little on the rail. PUNCHY KELL flashed brief foot, three wide.
