LEGACY AFFIRMED saved ground, rallied around the turn, slipped inside EL WINDO to gain the lead in deep stretch and lasted. IN MEMORYOFARIEND forced the pace four wide, finished strongly. MONEY ISSUES prompted the issue from the inside, gained a slim lead in the upper stretch, missed in a strong effort. EL WINDO set the pace on the rail dug in through the stretch but came up short in a good effort. STAR PATRIOT trailed for three quarters along the inside, closed with a rush through the lane. LIVELY REPARATIONS stalked the leaders five wide, lacked a closing bid. COVER MY SIX pressed the issue three and four wide, tired. MESHWAAR tardy at the start, was used up after a half while three wide.
