HENRY BERRY dueled from the inside early, remained engaged entering the turn, battled with the winner through the stretch but was outfinished. STAR OVER DUBAI chased the early pace from the outside, remained forward entering the drive but could not keep pace. LAW'S HILL pressed the early pace from the outside but was no match late. ROYAL COMMAND went evenly. ORIGINAL WAY could only pass tired ones. KIDS GOT SKILLS was no factor. LIFE ON THE RIVER was no threat. SHOPTILYUODROP H had a steady fade. MR. JENKINS raced wide throughout and was outrun.
