Footnotes

GOOD SONG, shuffled back into the first turn, settled off the pace about the three path, bid leaving the five sixteenths pole, contested the final turn two deep, took over a slim lead into the stretch and dug in under determined encouragement to hold sway. SHES GOT ENERGY steadied at the heels of Set Sail into the first turn, settled back off the rail, bid from the three eighths pole, angled outward on the final turn, entered the stretch in the four path and closed steadily to get place late strides. CATTAIL RUN was hustled to a slim early lead off the rail, rated her speed to the five sixteenths pole, was pressured toward the quarter, contested the rail rounding the final turn and continued a close factor to deep stretch before reluctantly yielding. CREATIVE ROSETTA, unhurried off the rail, was blocked through the final turn, eased to mid track making her bid entering the stretch and finished evenly. BELLE VALEE settled back from the early pace inside, was shuffled back toward the final turn, bid four wide at the quarter pole and finished evenly. VIVETTE chased the pace in mid track, improved her position through the final turn but had nothing left in the lane. SET SAIL was not a factor while racing outside. RUNAWAY VALAY was no factor while racing off the rail. ICY LOVER was shuffled back into the first turn, kept off the pace about the three path, saved ground making a bid nearing the final turn then weakened in the stretch. CADENCE'S ACCOLADE was hustled toward contention while angling inward approaching the first turn, stalked the pace two deep into the backstretch, gave chase past the five sixteenths pole then faded rounding the final turn.
