Footnotes

QUICKETIA settled back about the three path, bid at the rail nearing the quarter pole, angled four wide midway on the final turn, came between horses at the top of the stretch, dueled to the lead inside the sixteenth pole and inched ahead nearing the wire. AMAZON QUEEN broke through the gate prior the start, settled back in mid track, bid toward the quarter pole, circled rivals through the final turn, entered the stretch five wide and dueled to a slim brief lead at the sixteenth pole before grudgingly yielding. ALLEN'S LAST DANCE, off the pace inside, bid at the rail leaving the three eighths pole, eased three wide through the final turn, drifted outward while taking a slight lead entering the stretch then leveled off the final sixteenth. INTIMATE STORM was hustled to the front, set the pace inside, stayed near the lead through the backstretch, contested the final turn then weakened in the stretch. P K S CARMEL KELLY stayed with the early pace two deep, contested a slight edge through the backstretch, relinquished control into the lane and gave way from there. CONSOLIDATED GOLD steadied the first turn then faded toward the quarter pole. NORMA THE STORMA never factored.
