ROCKINGGLENROY broke up front, dueled through the first turn inside, narrowly set the pace into and through the second turn, shook clear in the third bend and was not seriously threatened in the drive under firm handling. VIVO allowed the pace to go early, called on for some run three wide in the final turn, could not get to the winner. ROCKY TWIST forwardly placed inside under stout restraint for six furlongs, moved out, tracked through the final turn, lacked the necessary response in the drive. SMOKEN BOBBE off the pace for seven eighths, bit closer while between rivals into the lane, finished up evenly while also found lacking in the late going. SIR PRIZE vied up front outside the winner for almost seven furlongs, faltered. CONFEDERATE SILVER off pace, steadied slightly in traffic with a half mile remaining, enjoyed a clean trip along the rail turning for home, lacked a kick in the drive. EL PISTON failed to menace.
