Footnotes

SALT AND LIGHT away in good order along the inside, vied early, shook clear before a quarter while continuing along the rail, not threatened in the drive under token encouragement to win ridden out. SPECIAL EXCHANGE also broke with the first group, vied briefly between rivals and outside the winner, chased that rival into and through the turn, could do little with that rival in the drive, clearly second best. TRAMICI BAY back off the pace along the inside, made a modest advance along the inside late in the turn, no match for the top two in the drive, clear of the others. BACK TALKING broke well from the outside, fell quickly back to trail, came on the outside for the drive, four wide into the lane, improved position while not a serious threat. CRAFTYHEART turned in an even effort in lacking a late bid. TURKEY RUN lacked early foot, failed to menace. CASH OR CHEQUE vied early outside the top two, began to fade after a quarter.
