Footnotes

BAY BUTTON BILL came in making light contact with Lucky Citizen after the start, settled close inside, lacked room steadying midway on the final turn, bid inside the drifting runner-up entering the stretch and held well with steady handling. VAN LEROY rated a slim lead inside, was pressured from the quarter pole, drifted slightly outward while losing front position entering the stretch but dug in under determined handling to retain place. DR. BALIN, bumped after the start, kept just off the pace outside, bid leaving the three eighths pole, contested the final turn two deep, was carried outward entering the stretch then unfinished in the duel for place. LUCKY CITIZEN, brushed lightly at the start, settled back outside, bid toward the three eighths pole, rounded the final turn in the five path then leveled off in the stretch. WHAT TIME rated close to the early pace about the three path then lacked significant response from the five sixteenths pole. MR. ZULU showed no speed off the rail and only a mild bid in the three path of the final turn. AMERICAN STEEL came away awkwardly and bobbed a stride from the gate, quickly moved to contest the early pace two deep, continued a close factor to the five sixteenths pole before giving way. OFFLEE WILD KISSES was kept close to the early pace about the three path, made a bid leaving the three eighths pole then faded on the final turn. DANCEMAILMANDANCE saved ground to no effect. WESTERN FRONTIER was not a factor.
