CAME EAST outrun for a half while saving ground, began to move far turn, angled to the outside turning for home, finished full of run to be in time. SERGEANT SAXTON cleared toward the inside soon after the start, set all the pace, two path in to the lane when being challenged, drifted in a bit with a sixteenth to run denying MIA'S ANGEL the rail, caught in the final strides. FOLLOWING A STEWARDS' INQUIRY REGARDING THE STRETCH RUN, THE RESULT WAS ALLOWED TO STAND. SKELETON CREW in the second flight while off the inside, ranged up to challenge three wide turning for home, dueled past the sixteenth mile marker, outfinished. MIA'S ANGEL also in the second group, saved ground, closer into the stretch, lacked room, altered course midstretch, left with too much to do. CAPE SABLE pressed off the inside, gave way in the drive. LIONOFWALLSTREET lacked a rally while racing outside. DOMESTIC AFFAIR was never involved. STORM IN YOUR EYES off slowly, remained back.
