Footnotes

NICK FROM ARVERNE forwardly placed early while off the inside, closest to the leader out of the second turn, took over off the inside into the final turn, drew off, ridden out. HUMBLE PILGRIM got clear and to the inside soon after the start, showed the way for almost six furlongs, offered little resistance to the winner when that one came along side late backstretch, remained well clear for the place. ADDI BOY off the pace and the inside, fanned five wide into the second turn, finished best of the rest. IN MY CROSSHAIRS went evenly while saving ground. MARKET SQUARE HERO four wide through the first turn, continued well off the inside, four wide again in the second turn, had nothing left for the drive. HARRIETTS BOY stalked the issue for a half while three wide and began to tire. MOONSHINENBISCUITS refused at the start.
