RUN FAT BOY RUN stalked the early pace from the outside, steadily advanced outside up the backstretch, reached a striking position entering the second turn, responded when asked and steadily drew clear. JOYFUL KISS broke sharp from the inside to duel for the early lead, remained engaged up the backstretch with PULVERIZER, put that one away entering the drive, was engaged by the winner upper stretch and could not keep pace. ROCKING VALAY far back early, steadily advanced up the backstretch, responded and was gaining but too late. PUMA'S BLUFF went evenly while holding position. PULVERIZER dueled from the outside early, remained engaged up the backstretch then tired in the drive. SOUTHERN ADMIRAL could only pass tired ones. YOU RASCAL pressed the early pace outside and tired. BLIZZARD BUSTER had a steady fade. INNER POWER was finished early.
