Footnotes

DARNLITTLECASH was off slow, was unhurried while hugging the rail around the first two turns, advanced inside down the backstretch, split rivals leaving the quarter pole, took the lead nearing the lane and readily drew off while ridden out. PITT MANEUVER set the pace along the rail, turned back several bids down the backstretch, was collared by the winner nearing the lane, could not match strides with that rival in upper stretch and held well clear for the place. CITY SKY saved ground around the first two turns, circled six wide around the far turn and was along late for the show. ALEX A FORTIORI lacked speed while racing four and five wide and passed tiring rivals. JOHAR'S BIG CHARM was unhurried while racing three wide around the first turn and two wide between rivals around the clubhouse turn, bid between rivals leaving the seven-sixteenths pole but tired around the far turn. JUDE THE DUDE was extremely wide around the first two turns and failed to menace. MILLENNIUMSUNRISE was off slow, raced seven wide around the first turn, was a mere four wide around the clubhouse turn, advanced outside down the backstretch, raced five wide around the far turn and faded in the lane. BLACK TIE DINNER stalked the pace four wide, bid outside midway down the backstretch and tired around the far turn. JOEY P JR. pressed the pace two wide and faltered around the far turn. ROB THE SANDMAN rushed up three wide around the first turn then steadily retreated inside. The rider of PITT MANEUVER claimed foul against the winner but the Stewards could find no reason for disqualification.
