BIG JIMMY J. set the pace on the rail, held clear into the stretch then was all out to last. NO BODY'S SON off a step slow, advanced four and five wide, closed with a rush through the lane. JAMES WOOD pressed the issue three and wide and finished well. REFLECTED AFFAIR prompted the pace from the inside, loomed boldly on the turn, came up empty in the drive. RINGEYE with the leaders from the rail, finished willingly. DOUBLE TOLLGATE five and six wide, lacked a closing bid. CIVIL HAT within striking distance five wide, lacked the needed rally. RUN THE COLORS was used up after three quarters while four wide.
