Footnotes

DRESSED UP settled back from the early pace toward mid track, advanced his position from the three eighths pole, bid a pole later, saved ground taking aim on the final turn, dug in for the lead in midstretch and edged clear from there. UNBRIDLED TUNE rated close about the three path, moved alongside the early leaders near the three eighths pole, took over at the five sixteenths pole, saved ground to draw clear on the final turn then dueled to midstretch before leveling off. SCARY STORM, awkward at the break, was jostled early, settled back inside, bid from the five sixteenths pole, eased four wide rounding the final turn then leveled off through the lane. ROADHOUSE ROMEO, well back inside, made a mild bid from the three eighths pole, rounded the final turn three wide and had nothing further down the lane. SMART SAINT stayed with the pace inside, came under pressure from the three eighths pole and remained close to the quarter pole before fading. FAMILY CHIEF moved to the lead for inside position approaching the first turn, rated with the pace two deep the opening half mile then faded toward the quarter pole. BRAAK'S DEPUTY and MADDEYTON were not factors. CALL OF FAME stalked the early leaders in the four path then faded from the half mile pole. DIXIE SUMMER'S, shuffled back early, moved well off the rail and trailed.
