**Footnotes**

ALL I NEED TO KNOW chased the early pace toward mid track, drew to even terms four wide midway on the turn, took control into the stretch, dueled clear toward the sixteenth pole and widened under steady encouragement from there. PRISONER OF HOPE lacked room while three and four wide through the backstretch, picked up the chase from the quarter pole and dug in under a hard drive down the lane to get the nod for place. RAPID VICTORY chased the pace outside, improved six wide rounding the turn, dug in at the outside flank of the runner-up through the lane and just missed the nod for place. SWELZEL was hustled with the early pace four wide, contested a slim advantage toward the three sixteenths pole, yielded to the winner leaving the turn then leveled off approaching the wire. SHORT HILL KIT KAT showed no speed well back toward mid track, saved some ground on the turn, moved to the outside entering the stretch and finished well. IDEAL THOUGHTS was hustled with the early pace two deep while between horses, saved ground toward the turn, contested the rail to the head of the lane and weakened from there. A GOOD RUN, in close early chase two deep, lacked room near the five sixteenths pole then weakened in the lane. MOON GLO MAE was hustled with a slim early lead three wide, contested a disadvantage two deep on the turn then weakened in the lane. KARDOKAN showed no speed giving distant chase inside. MISS CITY SLICKER was hustled with the early pace inside, shuffled back at the rail leaving the five sixteenths pole then weakened on the turn.
