CASSIE'S BOOT gained a slim lead early, made a clear lead turn, drew off through the stretch under a drive. LA KOPPA CHICA pressed the pace from the inside, came three wide on the turn, lacked a closing bid. LOLIBOP moved up along the inside, rallied around the turn, failed to sustain her bid. ANNARITA four and five wide, lacked the needed rally. BLACK BRIDLE on the rail down the backstretch, eased out three wide on the turn, never threatened in the drive. AMY'S AFFAIR up close early, steadily fell back. WILD BLUE YONDER was no factor, four and five wide. CHASING DAYLIGHT well placed on the rail, propped midway around the turn and lost her rider then was vanned off after the finish.
