SWEET SUSAN prompted the issue three wide, drew off around the turn then remained clear through the stretch while kept to a drive. BAHIA BEACH set the pace under pressure from the rail and was second best. PERFECT RULER off a step slow, moved up along the rail, finished willingly. SUPER BUGGY forced the issue from the inside, lacked a late response. SUBIRA stalked the leaders along the inside, eased out four wide on the turn, lacked a closing bid. PETULANT three wide down the backstretch, came five wide around the turn, never threatened in the drive. GOOD SONG three wide along the backstretch, dropped to the rail on the turn, lacked the needed rally. RAVENSCOURT pressed the pace just off the rail, tired.
