**Footnotes**

BROOKS IN TOWN settled back toward the inside, started a bid leaving the three eighths pole, improved near the rail rounding the final turn, angled three wide approaching the head of the lane, dueled to the front midstretch and drew clear in later yards. EXPLOSIVE WHIRL settled off the pace outside after bobbling a stride from the gate, bid leaving the seven sixteenths pole, entered the stretch four wide, was outfinished for the win though up late to get place. SUPER MOE rated off the pace off the rail, bid nearing the five sixteenths pole, rounded the final turn four wide, dueled to a slim lead leaving the turn, was caught midstretch and reluctantly ceded the remainder to the top two. LAST OF HIS KIND, well back off the rail, bid leaving the three eighths pole, entered the stretch five wide and finished evenly. FOXFIELD DRIVE stalked the pace off the rail, gave chase from the three eighths pole and held aim through the final turn before weakening. VIRGINIA GENTLEMAN raced well back outside. BLACK TIE DINNER raced well back in the three and four paths. EYE SEA A PIRATE raced quickly clear to rate the pace inside, was pressured past the five sixteenths pole and dug in with the edge most of the final turn before fading. GREEN GIBBON saved ground and was through early. GARDEN TAVERN, off the pace inside, faded through the backstretch.
