FOOLISHLY prompted the pace three wide in perfect striking position, gained the lead on the turn, lugged out then in from mid stretch on while clear and lasted. WILD BEA reserved six wide for a half, bid four wide around the turn, closed with a rush to just miss. TEE'S PEARL saved ground, rallied three wide on the turn and finished well. ABSOLUTE ROCKS stalked the pace three wide, finished strongly through the lane. CLAY'S ROCKET with the pace between horses, checked mid turn along the rail, was coming back in the stretch but was too late. STAR OF ANZIYAN forced the pace just off the rail, lacked a late response. MUSETTA'S WALTZ well positioned inside, lacked the needed late rally. SINGING LAUR rushed up four wide down the backstretch, flattened out. The rider of CLAY'S ROCKET claimed foul against the winner alleging interference in the stretch. The Stewards reviewed the video tape replays but found no evidence of a foul and allowed the original order of finish to stand.
