LAST TRAIN rated close inside, challenged the pacesetter runner-up nearing the five sixteenths pole, dueled to a slim advantage in mid turn and dug in under determined encouragement to draw clear from the sixteenth pole. GOLDEN STYLE rated a short lead inside, was pressured toward the five sixteenths pole, yielded a slim nod to the winner midway on the final turn, continued a close factor through the upper stretch but lacked further response and just lasted in place. SWEETIE, well back saving ground, bid leaving the three eighths pole, eased to the three path down the lane and just missed place. SAVIN BUZZBY stalked the early pace about the three path, gave chase leaving the three eighths pole but faded rounding the final turn. BAR ROOM QUEEN, off the early pace toward mid track, gave chase through the backstretch then leveled off on the final turn. HOLY BOOM was outrun and through early. ROCHE stalked the early pace in the three path then faded through the backstretch. GINGER KID lacked speed. MECARO, off the pace toward the outside, gave chase through the backstretch but had nothing left on the final turn.
