Footnotes

ESPORON stalked the pace four wide, took the lead between foes near the five-sixteenths pole, drew clear in the two path rounding the far turn and widened under a drive in the lane. LUCA'S WIND DANCER was unhurried in the two path around the first two turns, advanced three wide around the far turn and was up for the place in the final strides. BULL HOLE prompted the pace three wide, took the lead leaving the half-mile pole, vied between foes down the backstretch, angled to the rail entering the far turn, weakened and just lasted for the show. UNAPPROACHABLE lagged three and four wide early, rushed up outside down the backstretch, reached even terms nearing the five-sixteenths pole but failed to sustain his bid. GO MAIRE TU chased the pace inside and faded around the far turn. CLEAR REASON failed to menace while racing two wide. PETER G moved five wide to the lead around the first turn, angled in crossing the wire the first time, set the pace in the two path around the second turn, vied inside down the backstretch and faltered around the far turn. FIJI BOY was not a factor while racing three and four wide.
