Footnotes

NINJA NEKIA settled back about the three path, bid leaving the three eighths pole, closed steadily for the lead in midstretch and dug in determinedly to inch away from his nearest rival. CLARKE COUNTY settled well back inside, bid leaving the half mile pole, closed steadily from there with the advantage over the winner, was bested by that one midstretch and reluctantly ceded the final sixteenth. DUTYHONORCOUNTRY rated a clear lead inside, was allowed free rein rounding the final turn, came under a drive approaching the head of the lane, maintained the advantage in the upper stretch, was caught a sixteenth away and weakened at that point. FOXS UPTOWN BOY, unhurried outside, bid leaving the five sixteenths pole, rounded the final turn in the five path and leveled off after passing tired rivals. CHIEF EXECUTIONER and BEE REGAL were not factors. HARDROCK KID was kept close to the early pace inside, gave chase from the three eighths pole and faded on the final turn. ACT OF DOMINANCE was not a factor toward the outside. PARKER'S CHARM chased the pace in the three path though readily gave way after a half mile.
