Footnotes

RIBOT SUN was sent leaving the gate, set a pressured pace in the two path, edged clear leaving the three-eighths pole, drifted out a bit turning for home and drew off under a drive. BATTLE HARBOUR was caught six wide entering the first turn, angled into the three path leaving the five-eighths pole, briefly steadied midway around that bend, began to advance outside down the backstretch, made a bold move under a strong drive while four wide around the far turn to threaten the winner nearing the lane but could not match strides with that rival in the final furlong. APRIL'S FOIL stalked the pace four wide, faded around the far turn and just lasted for the show. DEALER settled off the pace while racing along the rail, angled out in upper stretch and was gaining between rivals late to just miss the show. BETTER STEP ASIDE pressed the pace three wide and gave way leaving the quarter pole. THE BUTLER DID IT never factored while racing two wide. STAND UP STAN failed to menace while racing two and three wide. WINDANCER'SBOLDONE chased the pace five wide and tired down the backstretch.
