Footnotes

DEBIT CARD settled back inside, bid four wide past the five sixteenths pole, angled inside the runner-up at the head of the lane and dug in to wear that one down the final yards. COUNTER MOVE rated off the early pace about the three path, moved to contention three wide leaving the three eighths pole, dueled to the lead approaching the final turn, dug in gamely to the winner's challenge from the top of the stretch but reluctantly ceded the final yards. HOOLIHAN, unhurried outside, came under rider's pressure toward the quarter pole, rounded the final turn in the four path and finished evenly in show. HEY DOC HOLIDAY, unhurried well back and outside, saved some ground through the final turn and passed tired in the stretch. DISCO INDY rated the pace inside, was pressured nearing the five sixteenths pole, contested the rail to the middle of the final turn and had nothing left in the stretch. SWALLOW THE FIELD was involved in an early duel inside nearing the first turn, was shuffled back toward the nine sixteenths pole, recovered stride into the backstretch, engaged the front runners between horses leaving the five sixteenths pole and continued chase to the quarter pole before fading on the final turn.
