MINISTERS ALTARBOY dueled from the inside for the early lead, remained engaged up the backstretch, shook loose from MR MARKET entering the second turn, opened a clear advantage at the eighth pole and was well clear while under steady urging. SINGIN THE BLUES outrun early, steadily advanced outside up the backstretch, responded entering the drive and finished well but could only gain the place. MR. MARKET dueled from the outside for the early lead, battled up the backstretch but could not keep pace. REGIONAL EXPERTISE well placed from the inside, remained forward for the drive but had nothing left. HE'S RISING could only improve position. SHALLOW FORD pressed the early pace inside but had nothing left. FIVE BOROUGHS forced the early pace outside and tired. VALHAR was no factor. SHINY BLUE was no threat. DAPPER DON forced the early pace and gave way.
