HOME RUN HITTER broke in a tangle, pressed the pace three wide, gained the lead on the turn, held clear through the stretch under a drive. LETS JUST DO IT advanced four and five wide, finished well. FREE JUICE set the pace for a half on the rail, gave way in the drive. JUDGE'S APPEAL rallied along the rail around the turn but failed to sustain her bid. WHO'S YA MAMA saved ground, bid three wide on the turn, lacked a late response. TRICIA'S ACCOUNT well positioned three wide, lacked the needed rally. MY CITY GIRL forced the pace four wide for a half, had little left for the drive. NASTY SABRINA was no factor four wide. REAL WOMEN showed little inside. A BARRY GOOD ACT in tight at the start, had little impact five wide.
