**Footnotes**

NET PROFIT rated a short lead inside, was pressured approaching the quarter pole and held well under a steady stretch drive. SHENANDOAH BOUND stalked the early pace from the inside, bid nearing the three eighths pole, held aim rounding the final turn but was turned back through the lane. PICKETTS CORNER, well off the pace off the rail, started a bid at the half mile pole, improved nearest the rail rounding the final turn then leveled off in the stretch. SURFING UP, off the pace in the three and four paths, eased out with a bid at the three eighths pole then leveled off in the five path of the final turn. SECOND BATTALION raced outside the opening turn, saved ground past the three eighths pole but had little left through the lane. HE'S MY BRO stalked the early pace off the rail, gave chase from the seven sixteenths pole, appeared to be off stride approaching the final turn and was eased from the head of the lane. GRANDE MAN CAN stalked the pace about the three path but showed no response through the backstretch. ART'S VOICE was not a factor.
