CAPTAIN TEN raced boxed at the rail from the second turn to the five sixteenths pole, bid angling three wide leaving the quarter pole and dug in determinedly through the stretch to get the nod the final strides. TURFMONSTER raced five wide early, took over after the opening quarter mile, rated a slim lead inside to the quarter pole, contested the rail rounding the final turn, dug in gamely through the stretch, missed the nod for the victory but retained the nod for place in a tight three way photo. NIK'S STAR CHOICE, off the pace in the three path, moved to contention four wide approaching the seven sixteenths pole, dueled to a slim advantage nearing the quarter, dug in gamely through the stretch though missed the nod for place in a tight three way photo. CLEVER CAT DIAMOND showed no speed two deep, made a mild bid rounding the final turn but leveled off through the lane. MR. APPOMATTOX stalked the pace two deep, dueled between rivals toward the five sixteenths pole then faded rounding the final turn. FIRSTIE, brushed early, stalked the early pace two deep, bore out making contact with Claysgator N Bears near the three eighths pole then weakened four wide rounding the final turn. FROG TOWN ROAD steadied the first turn then never factored inside. BRAAK'S DEPUTY came in brushing Firstie early then shuffled back into the first turn. CLAYSGATOR N BEARS stalked the pace three wide, was brushed steadying near the three eighths pole and faded from there.
