BELLE OF CAMDEN settled off the pace while racing two wide between rivals around the first turn, bid three deep entering the far turn, took command leaving the eighth pole and drew clear under a drive. TURNING LYPH was unhurried while saving ground around the first turn, rallied four wide around the far turn and was along for the place. JOLIE ANGE stalked the pace two wide, steadily gained around the far turn, reached even terms turning for home, could not match strides with the winner in upper stretch, dueled outside of PAGE'S PROMISE for the show and was just up for that share. PAGE'S PROMISE bobbed at the start, sprinted clear soon after the start, set the pace along the rail, was collared near the eighth pole, vied inside of JOLIE ANGE through the lane for the show and just missed. GLENORIE settled off pace while saving ground and lacked a rally. MY GORGEOUS never factored while racing three and four wide. BURR HILL GIRL was outrun inside. SAY WHISKEY raced three wide around the first turn, pulled up around the far turn and walked off.
