Footnotes

TIN PAN ALLEY CAT prompted the issue three wide, made the lead on the turn, held clear through the stretch while kept to a drive. PHIL'S PROSPECT five wide around the first turn, was three and four wide moving up thereafter and finished willingly. TAYLOR'S FLIGHT set the pace under pressure, remained a factor on the turn, weakened in the drive. SPORTY BOY advanced four wide but failed to sustain his bid. BAY BUTTON BILL saved ground but had no rally. VINCERO (URU) pressed the issue three wide, lacked a late response. HOLY WATERS saved ground, ran up on the heels of VINCERO on the last turn, checked and fell back. MAKUTUS flashed early speed three wide, pulled up on the turn and walked off. The rider of HOLY WATERS lodged a claim of foul against SPORTY BOY alleging interference around the last turn. The Stewards reviewed the video tape replays but found no evidence of a foul and allowed the original order of finish to stand.
